Dear Parents/Guardian,

National Day Celebration cum Sports Carnival 2017 (Primary 4 to Primary 6)

August will be a significant month for all of us as we celebrate our Nation's 52nd Birthday. In conjunction with the celebration, we will be holding a Sports Carnival. The theme for our Carnival is "Majulah! The Kampung Spirit @ MFPS". This theme is very apt and it aligns to this year's National Day theme "#OneNationTogether". The main objective of the celebration is to emphasise the importance of unity, as we bring the whole 'Kampung Mayflower' together as one community to celebrate, strive and have fun.

This year, the National Day celebration will be held on **Tuesday, 8 August 2017** at **Yio Chu Kang Stadium (for Primary 4 to Primary 6)** and **Yio Chu Kang Sports Hall (for Primary 1 to Primary 3)**.

Attendance and Reporting Time:

All Primary 4 to Primary 6 pupils are to report directly to **Yio Chu Kang Stadium by 7.30am**. Pupils who are taking the school bus will be dropped in school as usual. They will be ferried to the stadium via chartered buses accompanied by teachers on duty. Pupils with siblings in Primary 1 to Primary 3 will report to school together with their younger siblings and will be ferried to the stadium as well.

If your child is not feeling well on the morning of 8 August and is not able to attend the event, please inform the Form or Co-Form teacher or call the General Office at 6452 0849 latest by 7.20am to inform the school. This will help us to account for all pupils' attendance and safety.

Pupils walking to Stadium:

Pupils walking to the stadium are to use only the pedestrian crossings. Marshalls will be deployed along Ang Mo Kio Ave 6, Yio Chu Kang MRT station and the car park outside the stadium. CISCO officers will also be deployed along major road junctions to ensure safety of our pupils.

Programme:

The programme for the day will be as follow:

- 7.30am – 8.15am : Movement from school to stadium
- 8.30am – 9.00am : National Day Observance Ceremony and community singing
- 9.00am – 9.20am : ActiveSG workout
- 9.30am – 11.45am : Sports Carnival
- 12.00pm – 12.30pm : Dismissal from stadium

The Sports Carnival segment of the programme includes game stalls, telematches and traditional food stalls. These activities will get pupils to work together as teams, thus demonstrating community spirit and it also showcases our pupils acquisition of skills learnt during their Physical Education lessons.

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Refreshment:

Halal certified refreshments will be provided for all pupils. Please indicate in the acknowledgement form attached if your child requires vegetarian food.

Dismissal:

P4 to P6 pupils will be dismissed directly from the stadium at the end of the celebration. Pupils taking the school bus home will be ferried back to school to board their school bus. Pupils with younger siblings in Primary 1 to Primary 3, will follow them back to school. Marshalls will be assisting to ensure safe movement of pupils from the stadium to the various exit points.

Attire and things to bring:

All pupils are to be in their PE attire. We strongly encourage every pupil to bring along a water bottle and a poncho/umbrella in a small bag.

School Holiday on 10 August 2017

10 August 2017 is a school holiday. Pupils will report back to school on Friday 11 August 2017.
