# Parent-Child-Teacher Conference (PCTC), Briefing on Subject-Based Banding (SBB) for Primary 4 Parents

### 1. Parent-Child-Teacher Conference (PCTC)

PCTC is a time for parents, students and teachers to come together to find out more about the students' learning experiences in school. The objectives of PCTC for the various stakeholders are as follows:

### Parents/Guardian:

- to understand the holistic development and progress of child/ward;
- to be involved in child's/ward's learning; and
- to see child's/ward's authentic work in progress.

#### Child/Ward:

- to enable him/her to reflect and share his/her learning and progress for the semester and set goals for the new semester; and
- to allow him/her to take ownership of his/her learning.


### Teachers:

- to be better-informed on students' strengths, needs, behaviours, and learning style;
- to share on students' progress and challenges that may be interfering with his/her learning; and
- to discuss intervention strategies to stretch or better support students' learning.

Students need not report to school for lessons on **25 May 2018**. However, we strongly encourage you to <u>attend the PCTC with your child/ward</u> as he/she will be sharing his/her progress with you with guidance and input from teachers. We hope that by actively involving your child/ward in the conference, we can encourage him/her to take greater ownership for his/her learning. Please note that your child/ward is expected to come in his/her school uniform.



















### **Online Booking of Appointments**

You will need to book an appointment for PCTC through McOnline. Please access the website at <a href="https://www.mconline.sg">www.mconline.sg</a> and refer to the Step-by-Step Guide (Annex A) to book a time slot for the upcoming PCTC. The portal is open for booking from <a href="mailto:5.00 p.m.">5.00 p.m.</a>, 26 April 2018, Thursday till 12.00 noon, 4 May 2018, Friday. Please note that booking will be on a **first-come-first-served basis**. Only 1 booking is allowed per child/ward. You will be able to book an appointment slot with the Form/Co-Form teacher. Mother Tongue teachers will be in the School Hall to meet you.

Each parent/guardian will be allocated **15 minutes** to meet your child's/ward's Form/Co-Form teacher. As such, we seek your understanding and cooperation in keeping to the scheduled time. Please also note that there will be a short break for teachers from **10.30** a.m. to **10.45** a.m. and a 45-minute lunch break between 1.00 p.m. and 1.45 p.m. on 25 May 2018, Friday.

We have arranged for Hindi Language teachers to be in school to meet parents of pupils who are taking Hindi as their Mother Tongue Language in our school. No online booking is required to meet the Hindi Language teachers. The schedule for Hindi Language teachers is as follows:




