**Reason** for doing something

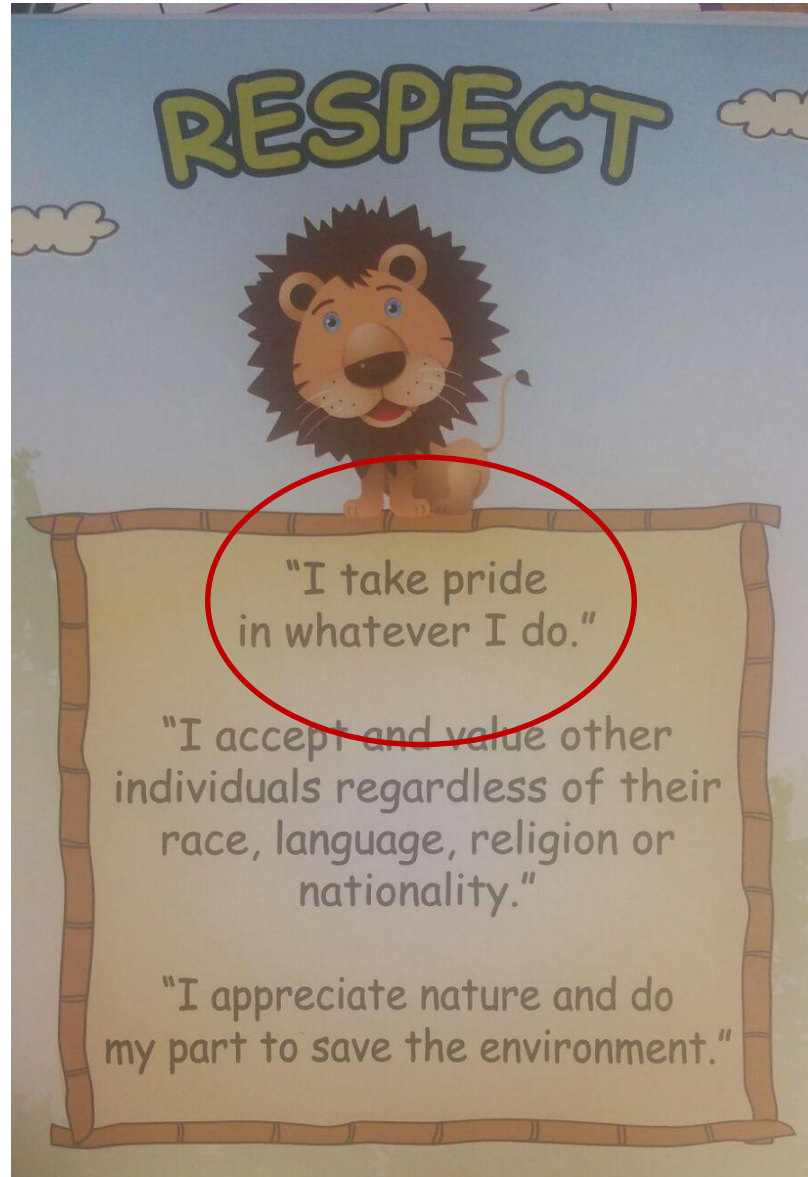


To **care** about what you do

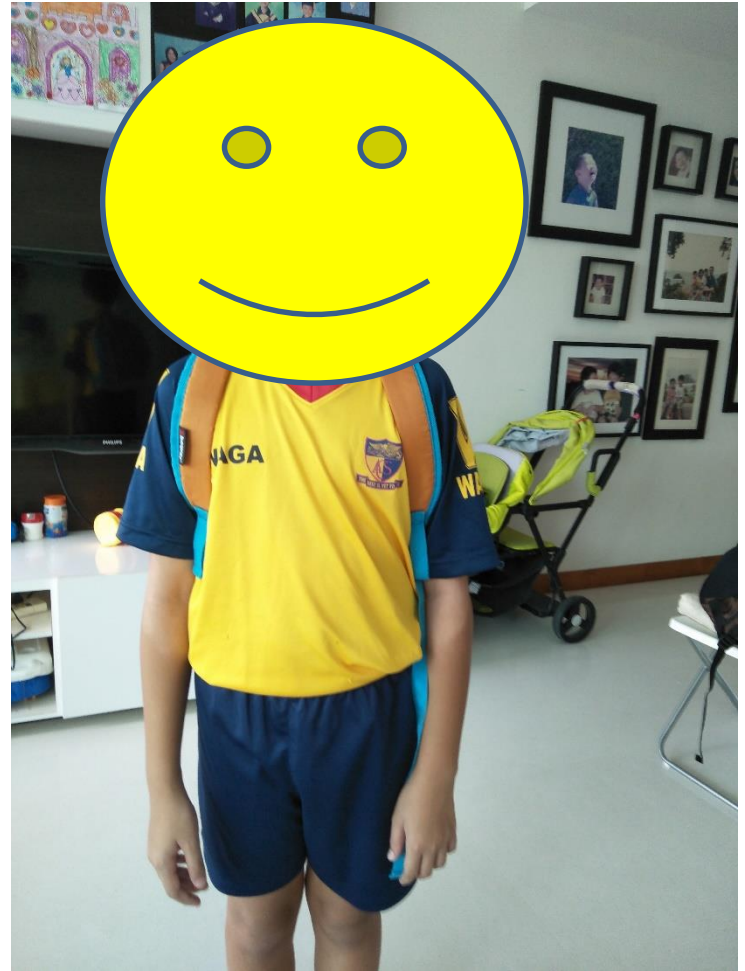
