1	Ezhishi - Digital Resources and Hardcopy Chinese Magazine (for students taking Chinese Language)	'Xin Lie Che' is a Chinese magazine for primary school students. It is a bi-weekly publication, totalling 20 issues for the year. The reading content is diversified, interesting and meets students' curriculum learning needs. The magazine also integrates language skills training such as oral, listening, writing and comprehension skills through reading and other activities.
