1	Ezhishi - Digital Resources and Hardcopy Chinese Magazine : (for students taking Chinese Language)	'Xin Lie Che' is a Chinese magazine for primary school students. It is a bi-weekly publication, totalling 20 issues for the year. The reading content is diversified, interesting and meets students' curriculum learning needs. The magazine also integrates language skills training such as oral, listening, writing and comprehension skills through reading and other activities. 2	Mother Tongue Language Activity (Chinese) : Chinese Calligraphy (for students taking Chinese Language)	Chinese calligraphy is the writing of Chinese characters as an art form, combining purely visual art and interpretation of the literary meaning. Students will learn the proper brush strokes in the 2 sessions. At the end of the programme, students will write a few Chinese characters using brush.	Term 1	-
