Post-PSLE Activities for Primary 6

The school has planned several post-PSLE activities for the students. Please refer to the attached Post-PSLE Activities Schedule. The following are a few highlights:

As part of Character and Citizenship Education (CCE) programme, students will be participating in a series of research and activity-based Values-In-Action (VIA) lesson-cum-project. The learning outcomes are to instill in our students, care for others and to contribute actively to the progress of our community and nation. As the beneficiary is the Children's Cancer Foundation, students will learn about cancer and understand the challenges faced by young cancer patients. The project culminates in the Fun(D) Fair whereby students raise funds and learn how these funds are used to help these children.

The PE Department has organised workshops on Bowling, Dragon Boating, Golf and Archery, as well as a Games Day to promote teamwork, cooperation and strengthen bonding among students. Students will also get to learn how to play the Cajon.

The school has planned talks on Financial Literacy to equip students with the knowledge to manage their finances. Outreach Talks by Secondary Schools as well as school visits for selected classes are organised to assist students to make informed choices in selecting their secondary schools.
