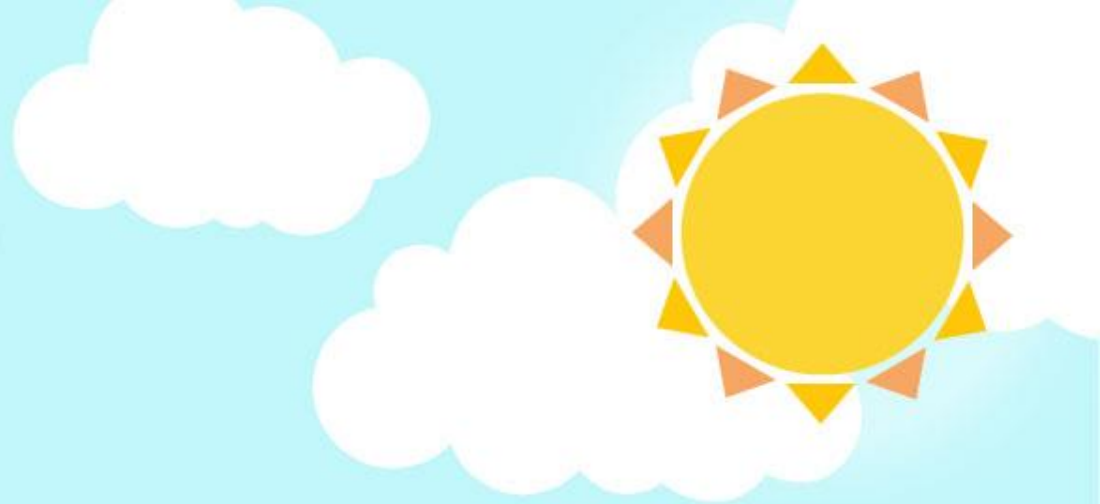

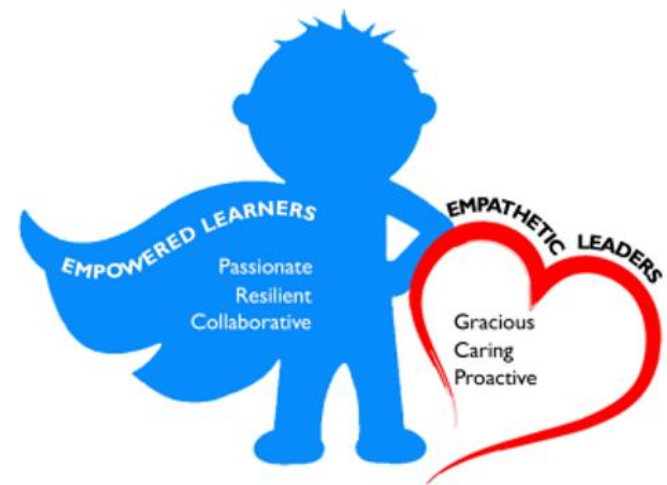

The Integrity Test

- Be quick to own up; (P1 & P2)
- Don't point a finger at others; (P1 & P2)
- Think of responsible ways to solve the problem; (P3 & P4)
- Repair the harm done; (P5 & P6)
- Restore the relationship. (P5 & P6)
